Key Achievements:

- Implemented an SQL database design (including intranet cloud front-end) through optimisation, normalisation (ETL) and redesign of existing information and system architecture in only 2.5 months (1 week early on an immovable deadline) making the "building" of a client order over 200% quicker (from an average of 45 minutes to under 20 minutes) and 1/10 the original database size! This included integration into Sage and Sage CRM thus creating a direct relationship between the Sales and Accounts information for the Production team. Average interrogation / build time 15 seconds on over 7m records! (after defining the criteria via a web front-end). Lessons learned at EAC re-applied here ALL data manipulation is performed via SQL Stored Procedures thus maintaining system and information integrity! Order turnaround is now "same day" where it was at 72+ hours previously.
- Passed TOGAF 9.1 with flying colours.
- Based on a previous robust System Design, easily integrated Call Logs and Webchats into the EAC CRM system, so that they are accessible from within to be viewed and listened to easily. Integrated Webchat information into the Call Centre system so that Users are logged in and out when accepting (up to a maximum of 3) Webchats.
- Implemented a new revenue stream for Communication Avenue whereby clients can pay an additional Gold or Silver premium to guarantee same day delivery. Now requires its own MI revenue report stream due to the additional volumes and revenue therein. Sales force said none of their clients would "go for it", I knew different!
- Improved SQL Stored Procedures and temp tables so that very large lists are now returned in under 1 second as opposed to several seconds previously. Extensive systems, information / data structure and architecture analysis prior to making the changes needed to be undertaken (an index update was not enough) including extensive ETL work to clean up said data from multiple sources.
- Solution, business, information analysis and final delivery of an online quote comparison system using asp / vbScript and SQL using a HTML and javascript driven front-end for household insurance, now generating over £0.5m p/m.
- Within 2 days, had found, verified and rectified an error on a 3rd party CMS that had stalled the programme for over 3 months and had cost dearly in terms of programme / project creep.
- Designed and wrote the technical specification for Towergate Northern. Project managed the development of said system that has gone on to generate over £2.2M GWP pa and the resulting document became the binder for that business.
- Achieved £1.5m profit for Towergate Lifestyle from the initial business analysis and solution design through to implementation and development of their online web presence using asp / vbScript and SQL using a HTML and javascript driven front-end.
- Received personal thanks from the **Canon UK** sales director for analysing, designing and implementing their online Incentive Scheme assessment programme system using asp / vbScript and SQL including data uploads from various formats.
- Helped win a £2M contract by analysing, designing and writing the systems' technical specification that became the backbone of the proposal - for the Argos online loyalty scheme project ("The Hive").
- Increased administration efficiency by 50% significantly affecting administration costs by designing and developing software for O2's long-term online sales incentive scheme ("The City"). Coded mainly in Flash with an asp / vbScript wrapper / data presentation and SQL back-end.
